Proposed trip to Toulouse (Thursday 7th to Wednesday 13th September, 06)

In order to take advantage of some of the attractions in the Toulouse area, this trip has been planned to enable the group to see the Aerospatiale facility at Blagnac airport, visit the observatory at Pic du Midi (~9400ft) in the Pyrenees, see the Norman Foster suspension bridge over the valley at Millau and visit the Rochefort caves nearby. After visiting Carcassonne, a walled town, an English couple will provide an opportunity to sample some local wines.

The group will stay in central Toulouse, in a family hotel, with many local activities including concerts, museums, art galleries, etc.

This trip was announced at the At Home meeting in January, and the response was such that there are only a few more places available.

The anticipated cost, per single person, including airfares, is about £750 for the full week, but it is not obligatory to stay for the whole week. For couples, the rate per person would be less. Fuller details will be available as soon as they are confirmed.
