We will walk from Waterloo to Vauxhall and cross the river over Vauxhall Bridge to Chelsea Embankment in order to avoid the tedious walk around the Battersea Power Station building site. The Chelsea side has some nice buildings such as Swan House by Norman Shaw and the much restored Crosby Hall. We cross back over Battersea Bridge and continue to Putney. It is mostly road walking but most of it pleasant.

Total distance is about 6½ miles.

Lunch will be taken in the Wetherspoons pub or “The Boat” on the river by Putney Bridge.

Meet at Waterloo Station for an 11:00 start. Toilets and refreshments. Meet between the close exits 5 and 6 at the west end of the concourse.

After lunch we will walk up the shopping high street to the station for trains back to Waterloo. All within the freedom pass area.
