This is a walk to break the ice for people after over a year of not coming into London. There will be interesting industrial and social buildings to see and learn about their history. On the route, which is between City Road and Kings Cross, we shall see Sadlers Wells, the New River Head, Finsbury Old Town Hall, Bevin Court near Percy Circus, the building where the Courtauld Institute carries out examination of works of Art and the Derby buildings for healthy living in Victorian times in just 2 hours. The distance is about 2 miles, more down than up, on narrow pavements with some wide roads to cross. Stoutish shoes would be a good idea.

Bearing in mind the recent health restrictions, coupled with the need to hear what is said, not only by the speaker but by all the contributions you may make, we are keeping the attendance to 12 people. If the event proves popular then we shall repeat it.

We shall meet by public transport at 11.15 in the Islington High Street area. Precise joining instructions will be issued to successful applicants, together with our mobile phone numbers in case of delays in arrival.

There will be no fixed arrangements for refreshments, but early arrival should allow coffees and loos to be found before the start and there are lots of places to find lunch in the Kings Cross area.
