This visit has been organised by George Freeman with help from Peter Quested (BCAST)

BCAST is the Brunel Centre for Advanced Solidification Technology and focuses on fundamental and applied research on solidification of metallic materials. www.brunel.ac.uk/bcast. ETC is the Experimental Techniques Centre which specialises in high resolution physical and chemical analysis for consultancy and research.

BCAST was established in 2002 and is the EPSRC centre dealing with all aspects of metal processing. It concentrates on fundamental research, technical developments and industrial application for all metals, but mostly aluminium or magnesium based ones. Another section is aiming for a sustainable metal market without so much fresh metal input via recycling. They can carry out continuous casting of components used in industry varying composition and conditions that cannot be investigated in industry. They have a second building that they are equipping which we will also see. This centre is a LIME Hub.

ETC is equipped with world-class imaging and analytical instrumentation and has expert technical staff. It supports research across Brunel as well as providing a UKAS-accredited commercial service externally. The materials characterisation work covers a range of disciplines: engineering, physical and biological sciences and the environment. For example, they can directly measure the size of unit cells with their XRD equipment.

We will be given a talk and guided tour of both BCAST and ETC.

MEET Assemble in Eastern Gateway, the main reception. We will be collected there. There is a small coffee bar there at the far end.

Public transport: from central London the Metropolitan line takes 40 minutes from Baker Street and, in the rush hour only, the Piccadilly line takes 50 minutes from Earls Court. If necessary, use busses from the station. It is a 10 minute walk.

From west London use buses; from Heathrow the A10 is fast to Uxbridge every 15 minutes taking 25 minutes. Alight at the Greenway and use the footpath 10 to 20 yards behind you on the right.
