

VISIT TO FINCHCOCKS MUSICAL MUSEUM
ON
THURSDAY 26TH APRIL 2012



Fincocks is a fine Georgian manor set in a beautiful garden and parkland. It is located near Goudhurst in Kent (TN17 1HH). It houses a celebrated collection of 100 historical keyboard instruments, of which many are in full working order. Demonstration-recitals are given and visitors have the opportunity to play the instruments themselves.

There is also a fascinating collection of prints, music and ephemera on the theme of the 18th and 19th century pleasure gardens.

Lunch can be obtained in the cellar restaurant, the main course to be chosen in advance of the visit. Picnics are permitted in the garden.

The visit would begin at 11.00 am with coffee, then at 11.30 am: An introduction to Finchcocks and a look round the smaller rooms of the museum, the pleasure garden exhibition and garden.

12.45 pm: Lunch

2.00 pm: Demonstration-recital in the hall

3.15 pm: Teas available

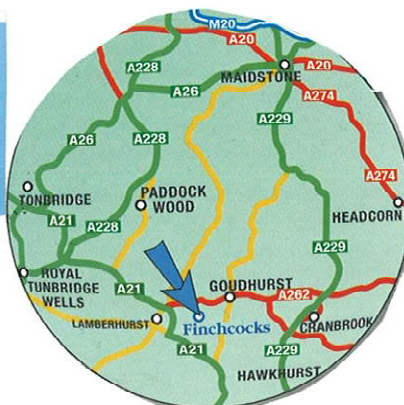
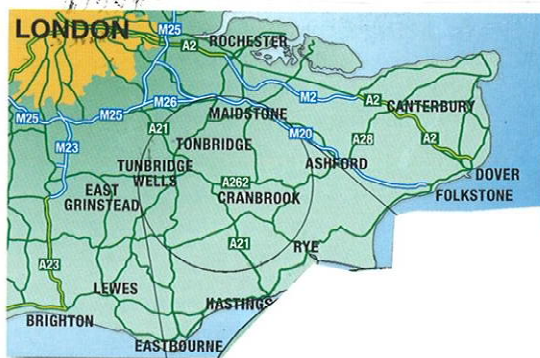
4.00 pm: Departure

Location



By Road:
Finchcocks is off the A21, on the A262 two miles west of Goudhurst village. Entrance is by the Green Cross Inn.

By Rail:
Paddock Wood rail station is approx seven miles away and there is a taxi service.
